

CSA Share Information



Typical large August share: salad mix, spinach, beans, bok choy, chard, onions, garlic, eggplant, fennel, radishes, basil, carrots, and strawberries

A large share consists of 9-13 items and typically provides a week's supply of produce for two to four people. It breaks down to about \$28 worth of vegetables per week, calculated using market prices. A small share consists of 6-9 items and provides produce for 1 to 2 people. It is \$20 worth of vegetables per week. We always include a few staples in each box: a bunched green, a root vegetable, an herb like parsley or basil, onions and garlic when available. The boxes will also include any other specialty seasonal vegetables.

Who is Barking Moon Farm?

We started Barking Moon Farm in October of 2006 when we moved from Montana to make a home in Oregon. We have ten acres in the Thompson Creek watershed where we raise certified organic vegetables and pastured poultry on several acres. We have several years experience farming organically in California, Oregon & Montana. In addition to our CSA program, we grow produce for area farmers' markets, restaurants and grocery stores as well as supply produce to the Siskiyou Sustainable Cooperative. We are committed to ecological farming principles, organic farming and whole farm sustainability.

What is Community Supported Agriculture?

Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is a practice of farming that focuses on high quality food production using organic methods. Neighbors buy shares or “subscribe” to the farm at the beginning of the season and receive a weekly box of produce from June into November. Our Community Supported Agriculture program aims to promote locally-grown food and build relationships between the farmer and neighbor. We are committed to organic farming and whole farm sustainability. We believe the CSA model is a perfect way to achieve these goals. Please join us for our 2010 CSA season!



How our CSA Works

Every week, between June and November (24 weeks total), your box of organic produce will be delivered to a convenient pick-up point. Toward the tail end of the growing season, we will host a farm tour and harvest celebration on the farm so that you have a chance to see where your food is grown. Other visits throughout the growing season can be arranged. We provide a newsletter and recipes with each box of produce that will give you information about our growing practices and crops as well as how to prepare the food you find in your box each week.
