We have been farming for six years. We have a homestead of ten acres with 4 greenhouses and eight acres in vegetable production.

How It Works

- * Neighbors buy shares or "subscribe" to the farm at the beginning of the winter season and receive a bi-weekly box of produce from December into February.
- * Every two weeks—six deliveries of produce total—your box of organic produce will be delivered to a convenient pick-up point.
- * We provide a farm update and recipes on our website with each box of produce.

Why join our Winter CSA Program?

- * You get fresh, organic vegetables during the winter season when there is not an abundance of local, seasonal produce available.
- * Your financial commitment to our farm during the winter season farming season is critical to help us fund seed purchases, employees, supplies, equipment, cultivation and planting (and get through the winter!)
- * Together, we create a strong personal connection as the food we grow makes it to your table, strengthening our community through locally-grown organic vegetables.
